Application Guidelines

Candidates must:

1. Have parents/guardians in agriculture and/or be actively involved in 4-H or FFA.
2. Be a full-time student, as a high school senior registering in a College, University or Technical school.
3. Have at least an average GPA (2.5 and above).
3. Demonstrate good character, leadership and interest in furthering their education.
5. Home residence is in Keith, Perkins or Arthur Counties.

Selection Guidelines

There will be a minimum of three members serving on the Scholarship Committee of the Area 14 Cattlewomen who will evaluate and score all applications. If a member of the committee has a relative applying, an alternate will be chosen to evaluate and score that application.

Recipients will be notified on or before May 1st.

A Scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to the top three applicants that are a high school senior, registering as a freshman in a college level school

The funds will be directly disbursed to the recipients' school in January, on a one-time basis.
