

Wallace Community Players Scholarship (updated 4/08)

Eligibility: This scholarship is open for any graduating senior from Wallace High School who has participated in speech and /or drama in a school or community setting. The scholarship amount will be \$200 and multiple awards may be given at the sole discretion of the selection committee.

- Students will submit an application letter containing the following information through the school guidance counselor no later than March 1.
- Include you name and address on your application.
- List your participation in speech and drama activities in both community and school. Feel free to list involvement prior to high school experience. Because this is the Wallace Community Players group, greater consideration will be given to applicants who have been involved in Children's Theater or other community performances, and present this information in their application.
- Write an essay, 500 1000 words, on how your involvement in speech and/or drama has added to your plans for the future.
- Entries will be judged by the current year's officers of the Community Players or any committee they may name. Judges related to the candidates will not serve on the committee. This organization reserves the right to withhold giving a scholarship in the event that there is no application deemed worthy to receive it.
- Students will be notified on or before May 1. The Scholarship will be paid directly to winner's school. It is the responsibility of the winner to provide to the Community Players the name and address of the school they will attend.
